Please note that only 52 emails were made available on the contact list and there are 151 entries in the contact lists, although this list also includes non-members and sub-members. Future work is necessary on the following tasks: 1) identify and consolidate information from duplicate party entries, 2) collect additional contact emails from confirmed parties and confirm current list of emails, 3) identify and collect information from parties without contact information, 4) confirm contact with parties that were previously not included in the member lists.
